4.1 <u>2023 IBC Landmark Research – Intelligent</u> Building Technology & Market Trends

The ASHB 2023 Landmark research project titled Intelligent Buildings Technology and Market Trends has been successfully completed and is scheduled for release to the funding organizations on February 27. 4.2 2024 IBC Landmark Research – Smart Building Trends & Technology Adoption



Marta Klopotowska gave a brief overview of Landmark Research Project titled Smart Building Trends & Technology Adoption. This project has garnered support from 15 funders thus far, and ASHB expresses sincere gratitude for their invaluable support and guidance. An RFP went out to ASHB member research firms late last year leading to the selection of Harbor Research by the initial funders. The research will utilize both industry expert interviews and consumer surveys (targeting 300 Commercial Buildings Owners/Operators in Canada and USA and will cover key topics/opportunities to gain an annual perspective of operator needs/outlook). It is essential to note that these projects, collectively valued at approximately \$80K USD, will have an exclusive release to the project's funders. There are two distinct funding tiers: Bronze, priced at \$5K, which grants access to the research findings, and Silver, priced at \$10K, enabling participation in the Steering Committee and shaping of the project's

An overview was given of the IBC White Paper review process, completed IBC White Papers and papers in progress. IBC White Papers are secondary literature review articles that are approximately 10-20 pages in length. These papers are written and distributed free of charge to inform the industry. For the papers to be approved by the IBC White Paper Sub-Committee (WPSC), they must have significant technical material of relevance to IBC members. They must not contain marketing material or promote an agenda. Any ASHB member can and is encouraged to complete the white paper proposal on the ASHB website.

All completed and approved ASHB White Papers are placed in the ASHB Public Library, Members Library, ASHB NewsBrief, ASHB Twitter Feed, and ASHB LinkedIn Group and promoted at industry events. 9. Other Business – Bob Allan (NAVCO, Inc.)

Bob Allan called for new business related to future IBC Guest/Keynote presentation topics and speakers, new IBC White Papers, new research projects and meeting ideas, etc.

David Katz (Sustainable Resources Management Inc.) mentioned his collaboration with a US company focused on installing new glass on existing buildings to aid in decarbonization efforts. He highlighted the potential to upgrade older building windows to

triple-pane or equivalent, emphasizing the importance of considering the building envelope in decarbonization strategies. David suggested having someone present on this topic.

Ken Wacks (Ken Wacks and Associates) added to David's point by mentioning a new crystalline technology for window panes that can generate power from transmitted light. He indicated his upcoming participation in a panel discussion at the Smart Energy Summit in Orlando, where he will speak on this technology.

David Katz (Sustainable Resources Management Inc.) mentioned his speaking engagement at NFMT in Baltimore, where he will showcase progress on utilizing building data for Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) purposes.

Michael Grant (Metrikus Ltd.) highlighted the increasing demand from customers for understanding and utilizing data effectively, particularly for purposes beyond technology. He suggested the potential for a presentation on data usage, including its applications for ESG, space optimization, ROI calculations, energy efficiency, and indoor air quality improvement, emphasizing the broader benefits beyond just energy savings.
